

You will need:

- White cardstock
- Printer
- Scissors
- Popsicle or jumbo stick
- Glue

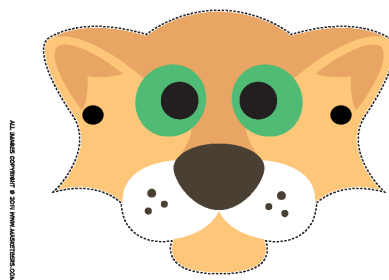
Optional:

- Hole punch
- Yarn or string
- Markers or crayons



Directions:

1. Print out either the colored or the blank cougar mask.
2. Cut out the mask along the dotted line in the colored mask or the solid line of the blank mask.
3. Cut out the black circles in the eyes to make the eyeholes.
4. If you opted for the blank mask, color your mask.
5. Glue a popsicle or jumbo stick onto the lower back of your mask.
6. Or using a hole punch, make a hole on each side of the mask (see below) and tie a piece of string or yarn to each hole for hands free cougaring!
