

L is for Lion and V is for Vulture

You will need:

- Construction paper
- Scissors
- Glue
- Marker

Optional:

Wiggly eyes



Directions for Lion:

Cut the following out of whatever color construction paper you
want your lion: large L, large circle (mane), medium circle (face), 2
small circles (ears), medium heart (muzzle), small heart (nose), tail,
tail tuft, front foot and back leg.



2. Cut fringe around the edge of the large circle.



3. Glue the muzzle, nose and ears onto the head circle and glue on wiggly eyes or draw on eyes.



4. Glue head onto the mane.



5. Glue head/mane onto the top of the L.

6. Glue the tail tuft onto the tail. Then glue the tail, front foot and back leg onto the L.



7. Using your marker, decorate your lion!



Directions for Vulture:

1. Cut out the following out of whatever color construction paper you want your vulture to be: a large V, medium circle, a head and a beak.



2. Cut out fringe on the outside of the V.



3. Cut waves around the edge of the circle (to look like fluff!) and glue onto the V.



4. Glue the head onto the circle and the beak onto the head. Glue on wiggly eyes or draw on eyes.
