

You will need:

- Cardstock paper or any heavy-duty paper
- Paint or markers
- Scissors
- Glue
- Ruler

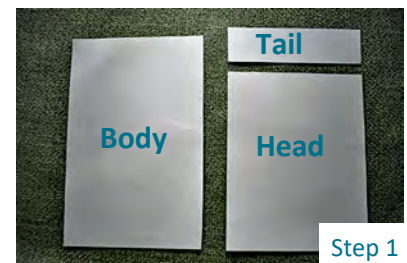
Optional:

- Wiggly eyes



Directions:

1. Cut a full sheet of cardstock paper (8 ½" x 11") in half. Cut a 1 ½" strip off an end of one of the halves.
2. Fold the body piece in half. Cut an arc out to make your cat's legs.
3. Cut a ½" slit at each end of the fold in the body (see photo).
4. Round off the corners of each foot and then make a ¼" fold on each foot.
5. Round off one corner and shape the tail strip into a tail shape.

- Fold the head piece in half and cut the bottom into a wide U shape.
- On one side of the head, make a cut from the side diagonally up to the fold. Repeat on the other side to make the cat's ears.
- Round off the corners of the ears.
- Find a good picture of a sand cat and decorate the head, tail and body of your sand cat with paint or markers.
- Glue the feet down onto a piece of paper to keep your cat from doing the splits!
- Slide the tail into the back slit on the body and slide the back side of the head into the front slit on the body. Enjoy the cuteness!
