

Elephants on a Roll!

You will need:

- Paper towel roll and/or toilet paper roll
- Marker
- Scissors
- Utility knife
- Paint or markers
- Glue

Directions:

1. Draw an elephant shape onto a paper towel roll (see picture).

2. Cut out the elephant shape.

3. Using an utility knife cut the ears and bend so they can stick out (see picture).

4. Using the scrap pieces of the roll, cut out two ¾" x 3" pieces for the legs of your elephant.













5. Glue the legs onto the bottom of your elephant.

6. Decorate your elephant.

7. To make a baby elephant, repeat steps 1-6 using a toilet paper roll! Note: make the leg strips ¼" x 2".
