

**You will need:**

- White cardstock
- Black cardstock or construction paper
- Glue
- Scissors
- Printer
- Paint, markers, colored pencils or watercolors

**Optional:**

- Wiggly eyes



**Directions:**

1. Fold a piece of white cardstock in half to make the card. Paint or color an Arctic background onto the front of the card.



Step 1

2. Print out the provided templates onto either white cardstock or cut out and trace onto cardstock. Then cut out your polar bear pieces.



Step 2

3. Glue the back of the polar bear's body onto the background.



Step 3

4. Cut three 1 1/2" x 3/4" strips of paper from cardstock. Accordion fold 2 of the strips and glue the strips as shown onto the back side of the front polar bear's body.



Step 4

5. Glue the strips to the back part of the polar bear body as shown.



6. Glue the black inner ears onto the white outer ears and glue both to the backside of the head (see picture).



7. Glue the nose onto the head and decorate your polar bear's face.



8. Accordion fold the 3rd strip and glue to the back of the head.

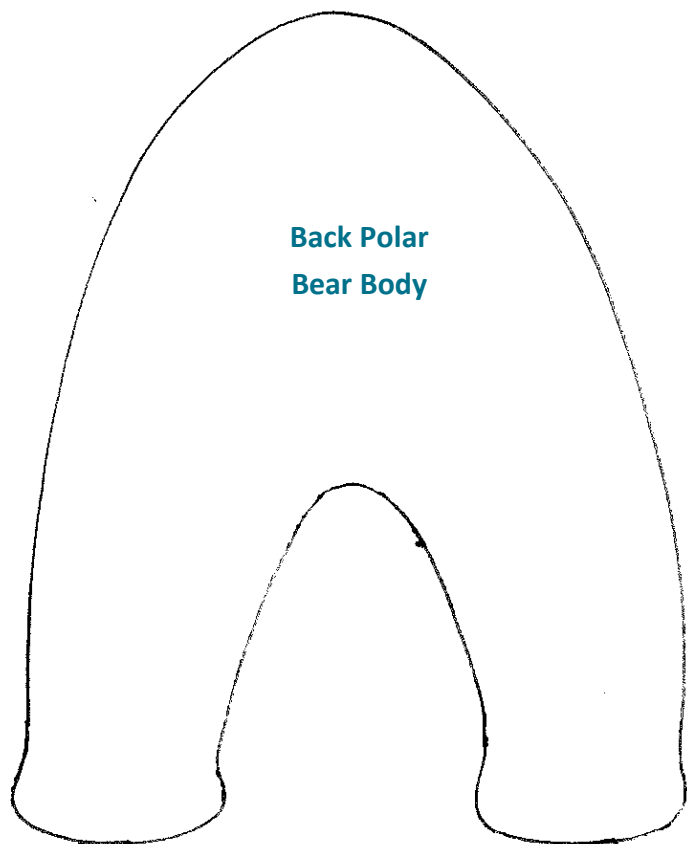


9. Glue the strip to the front body.

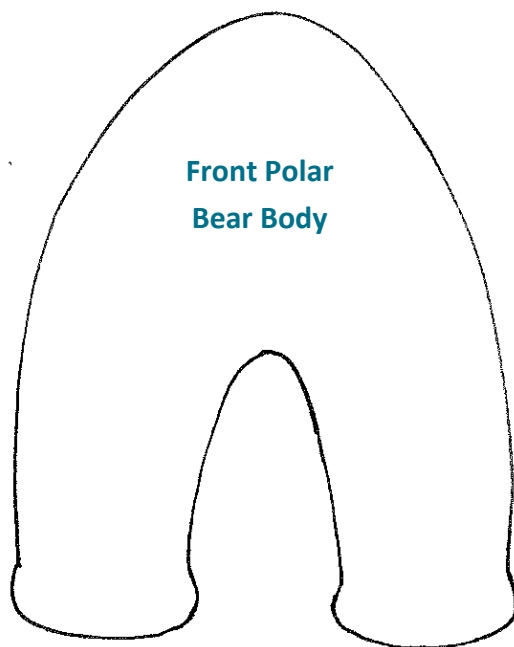


10. Write a message on the inside to your favorite person/people! Or make several and give them out at the holidays!

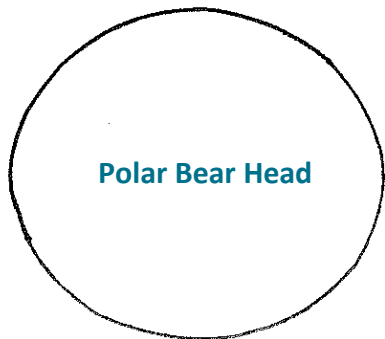
